Each organization will prepare a portfolio with the following five sections. The group can use their own creativity to represent their achievements in these areas for the current year. Each section will be worth 20 points. The portfolios will be reviewed and scored by a committee of faculty and staff members. The fraternity with the highest overall points will be awarded the William B. King Award. The sorority with the highest overall points will be given the Vivian V. Schild Award. The group with the highest score in the Campus Involvement section will receive the Sheila Averett Jones Award.

The Portfolio will be due on Thursday, April 17th. The Portfolios will be reviewed on Friday, April 18th.
