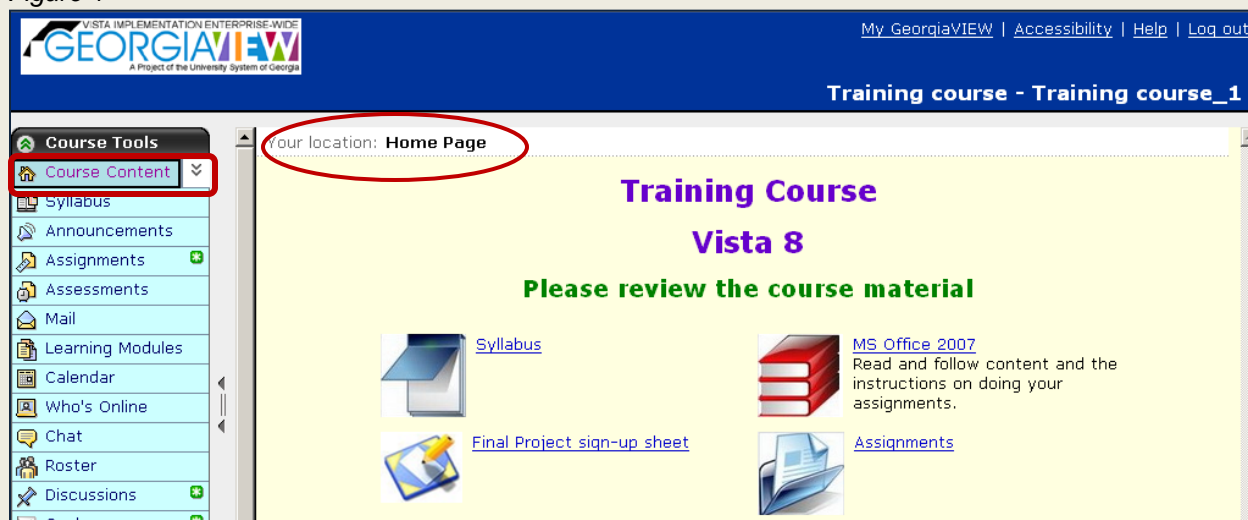


## Course Home page

When you click on your course link in GeorgiaVIEW, you will be taken to the course **Home page** (Course Content page). The Home Page is the main page for your course, as it provides an access point to the tools and content that has been added to the course (Figure 1).

The Home Page can contain a variety of icons; you can open the content by clicking an icon or its linked title.

When you access the course content, you are taken directly to a page where the content is displayed. For example, if an assignment has been added to the Home Page and you click its icon, you are taken to a page containing the assignment.



A quick way to return to the Home Page from anywhere in the course is to click the **Course Content** button under **Course Tools** with the Home icon  (Figure 1).


## Folders and Learning Modules



1. To keep the Home Page from becoming too cluttered, your instructor may add **Folders** to the Home page. You can think of these as sub-pages of the Home Page; they are simply another page to which content is added. There can be a default icon for a folder



or instructor's custom icon



2. Typically, your course will contain one or more **Learning Modules** . They are used to organize and deliver course materials to you. One way to think of learning modules is as "online lectures."

When you open a learning module, there are two ways to navigate the learning module content: the **table of contents** and the **Previous Page**  and **Next Page**  icons. If there is a table of contents, it will appear in the left-hand frame. You can navigate through the learning module by clicking the linked title of the page that you want to go to. Alternatively, you can click the Previous Page and Next Page icons that appear in the top right-hand side.
