*Helping Students*—The Silent Auction raised \$2,633 to fund Alumni Association scholarships.



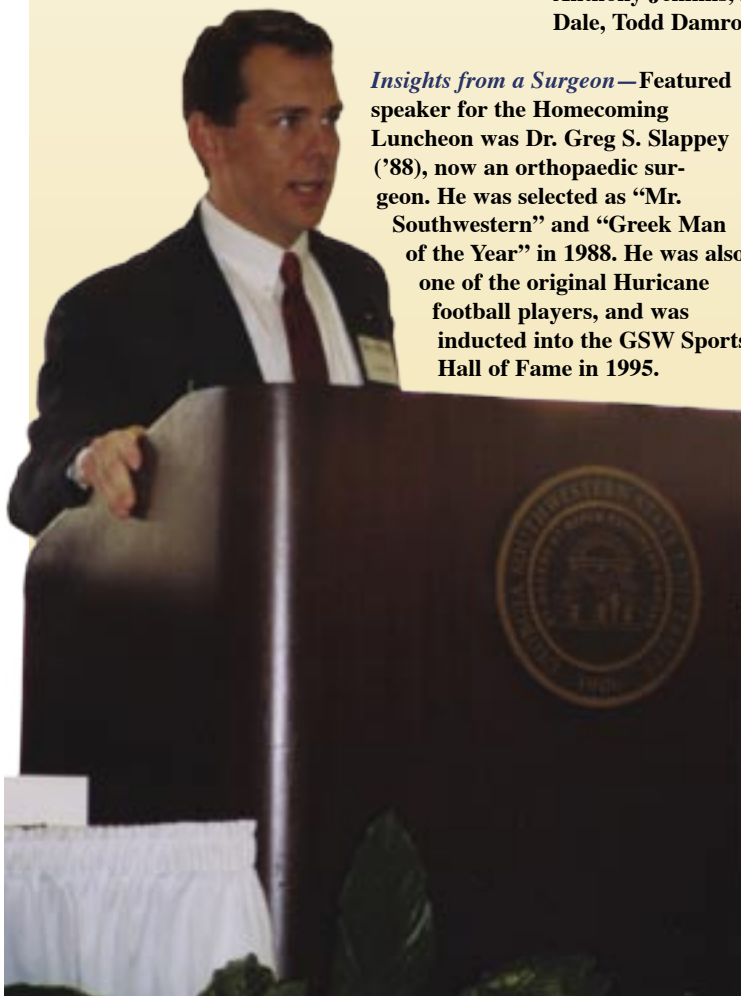
