1. Submit your \$45 acceptance deposit (tuition prepayment) to reserve your place in the freshman class. The deposit may be submitted online at [gsw.edu/deposit](http://gsw.edu/deposit) or by mail using the Acceptance Deposit Form.
2. Plan your visit. Georgia Southwestern offers several ways to visit campus. Go to [gsw.edu/visit](http://gsw.edu/visit) or [gsw.edu](http://gsw.edu) and click on "Visit" to schedule your tour online.
3. Complete your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by going to [fafsa.gov](http://fafsa.gov). Southwestern's school code is 001573. Our Office of Financial Aid encourages eligible students to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool to view and transfer your tax information from the IRS. For questions about loans, grants, or work-study, contact the Office of Financial Aid at (229) 928-1378.
4. If applying for any financial aid, accept terms and conditions by returning the completed form found on the Office of Financial Aid website.
5. If eligible, complete the online Beginning Freshman Scholarship Application before the February 1st priority deadline. To check scholarship eligibility and apply, go to [gsw.edu/scholarship](http://gsw.edu/scholarship).
6. Submit your Application for Student Housing along with the \$50 processing fee. Applications are emailed beginning in November.
7. Complete your vaccinations and submit your immunization form. Questions about required immunizations should be directed to the Student Health Center at (229) 931-2235.
8. All new students are required to attend a STORM Day orientation session. Online registration for STORM Day begins in January. Go to [gsw.edu](http://gsw.edu) and search for "STORM Day."
9. If eligible for Georgia in-state tuition, check your admissions status online to ensure Proof of Lawful Presence has been satisfied. For more information, visit [gsw.edu](http://gsw.edu) and search for "Lawful Presence."
10. Upon graduation from high school, have your official final high school transcript sent to the Office of Recruitment and Admissions.
11. If you participated in dual enrollment, have your official college transcript sent to GSW. Also if you earned AP/IB credit while in high school, have those official scores sent as well.
