	• The Senate & House approved the 1 st phase of the	
	Health & Human Science Building. The Governor	
	will hopefully approve by November 1 st . The 2 nd	
	phase will require the University to come up with	
	additional money to complete, which will entail	
	borrowing approximately \$3 million dollars. The	
	President expressed thanks to Representative	
	Cheokas for his strong support in this matter.	
	• ICAPP Grant – GSW is 1 of 7 institutions to	
	receive \$140,000 from this initiative.	
	• Korea – President Carter donated the money	
	received from his trip to Korea to the RCI.	
	• Summer School – Dr. Blanchard expressed concern	
	that the issue of summer pay had caused some	
	faculty to decide not to teach this summer. Full	
	funding will be available for 2010 summer school	
	salaries. Class sizes will remain a problem. It is	
	important to keep the numbers up. An attempt will	
	be made to make adjustments early if needed next

Discussion with the Vice President	 The following developments were discussed by Dr. Adler: Multiple faculty have volunteered to develop online core courses and a considerable number of courses will be added. Commended the Academic Honors Convocation Committee for recognizing and expanding the academic achievement of students. SACS Committee – Work is currently being done to develop a protocol to determine the identity of students taking online classes. Evaluation of Lecturer and Senior Lecturer positions are being developed. Although there is an increase in students, hiring of new faculty continues to be problematic. The Board of Regents if leaning toward this development. Commendation for Chuck Huffman for chairing the Prior Learning Assessment Committee. GSW has been designated as an Adult Learning Center.
