


# **Roommate Group Instructions**


This set of instructions explains how to request to be housed with someone. If you have already been assigned a roommate and want to change, you need to email <a href="mailto:housing@gsw.edu">housing@gsw.edu</a> so they can update your assignment. If you have already completed the housing application and you have now found someone you want to live with, you can go back into the housing application and complete these steps.

To navigate to the housing application, please view the instructions on our website entitled "Housing Application Instructions." Once you get to step 11 about Roommate Groups, you can start using the instructions in this guide.

1. Once you have identified who you want to live with, choose one person in the group to be the "Group Leader." That person will need to go into their housing application and navigate to the "Roommate Groups" tab. Then click the button that says "CREATE GROUP" at the bottom of the page.




2. Enter a Group Name and Password. You can come up with whatever Group Name and Password you want, just make sure to write it down so you can share it with your future roommate. Then click "Save Group."




3. You will then be navigated to a page that shows your Group Information.

4. The person you want to live with then needs to go into their housing application and onto the "Roommate Groups" tab. They will then select "Join Group."




5. They will then enter the same credentials you created earlier. Then click "Join Group".



6. You will then be added into the group. If it is successful, the page will look like this.



#### A couple of notes about roommate matching:

- For Pines: residents are housed in 4-bedroom apartments. Only groups of 2 or 4 will be accommodated. Groups of 3 will need to find a 4<sup>th</sup> roommate to live with, or the group will need to separate.
- Roommate Groups last for the Fall and Spring semesters; students are not re-assigned between the Fall and Spring semesters.
- Roommate assignments are typically sent out during the summer. Once you have already been assigned a roommate, you will need to email <a href="mailto:housing@gsw.edu">housing@gsw.edu</a> to make any changes.
- If you are a Group Leader and more people join your group then the room can accommodate, you will need to remove people from your group. Click the "Remove Roommate" button to do that.
- The system we use does not show the names of the people on the housing application. You can confirm the person is correct by reviewing their answers to the profile questions and checking their demographic information. If you are still uncertain, you can contact <a href="https://housing@gsw.edu">housing@gsw.edu</a> and we can check that the names are correct.
